WHAT IS "EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS ACT, (ESSA)"?

LIKE THE *NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND ACT*, ESSA IS A REAUTHORIZATION OF THE 1965 ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION ACT, WHICH ESTABLISHED THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S EXPANDED ROLE IN PUBLIC EDUCATION.

IT IS AN EDUCATION ACT, SIGNED INTO LAW DECEMBER 10, 2015, THAT AIMS TO:

- ❑ RAISE ACCOUNTABILITY
- ❑ PROVIDE MORE FINANCIAL FLEXIBILITY
- ❑ SET GOALS
- ❑ IMPROVE TEACHER QUALITY
- ❑ PROVIDE SCHOOL CHOICE
- ❑ MAKE SCHOOLS SAFER

EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS ACT, (ESSA)

UNDER ESSA, STATES GET TO DECIDE THE EDUCATION PLANS FOR THEIR SCHOOLS WITHIN A FRAMEWORK PROVIDED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT. THE LAW ALSO OFFERS PARENTS A CHANCE TO WEIGH IN ON THESE PLANS.

THE PLAN MUST INCLUDE A DESCRIPTION OF THE FOLLOWING:

- ❑ ACADEMIC STANDARDS
- ❑ ANNUAL TESTING
- ❑ SCHOOL ACCOUNTABILITY
- ❑ GOALS FOR ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT
- ❑ PLANS FOR SUPPORTING & IMPROVING STRUGGLING SCHOOLS
- ❑ STATE & LOCAL REPORT CARDS

EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS ACT (ESEA)

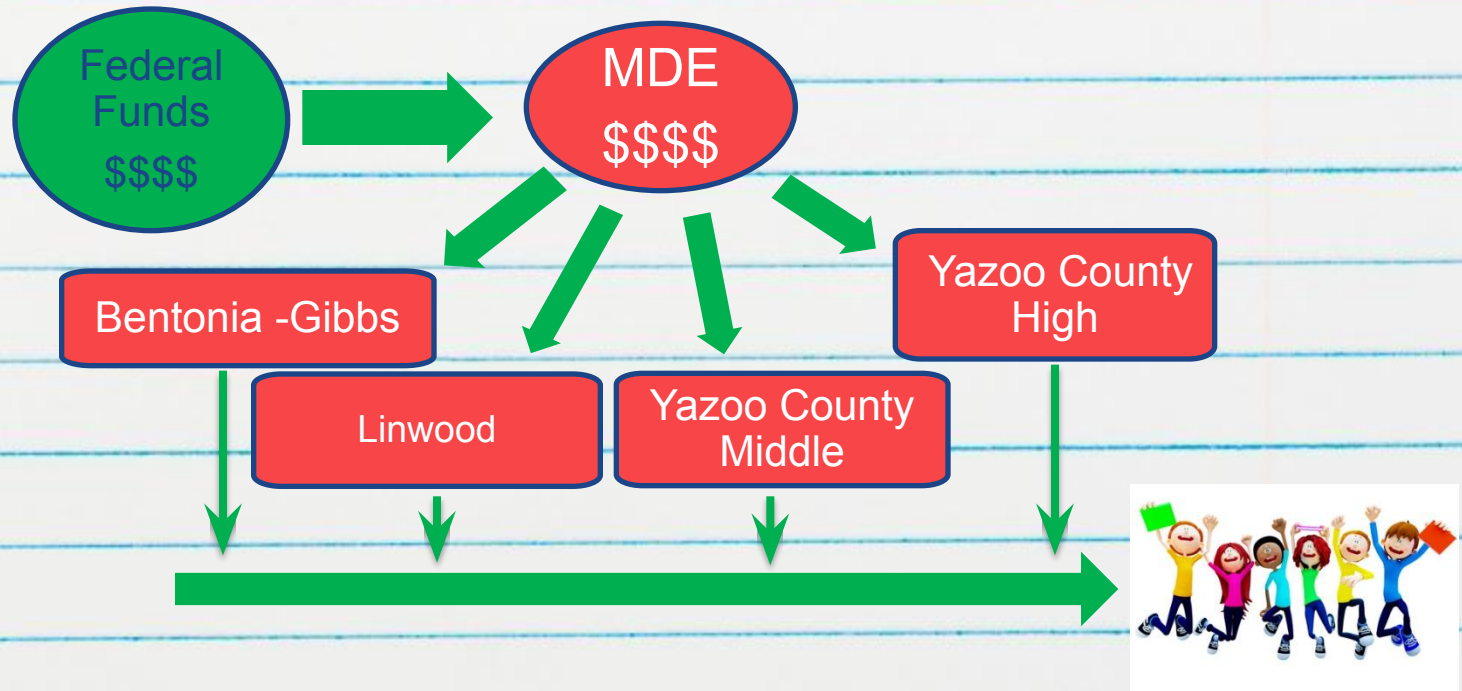
- ❑ PROVIDES SCHOOLS MORE MONEY
- ❑ HOLDS SCHOOLS ACCOUNTABLE FOR RESULTS
- ❑ GIVES PARENTS REPORT CARDS ON THE STATUS OF THE SCHOOL & DISTRICT.
- ❑ FOCUSES ON TEACHING METHODS THAT HAVE BEEN PROVEN TO WORK.
- ❑ REQUIRES READING & MATH TESTING IN GRADES 3 THROUGH 8 EACH YEAR & ASSESSMENTS IN GRADES 9-12 IN READING & MATHEMATICS.
- ❑ PROVIDES FUNDING TO IMPROVE TEACHER QUALITY
- ❑ PROVIDES STUDENT TRANSFER OPTIONS (IF ANOTHER SCHOOL IS AVAILABLE WITHIN THE DISTRICT)
- ❑ MAY PROVIDE YOUR CHILD WITH FREE TUTORING THROUGH SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES (SES) IF QUALIFIED BY MDE

WHAT IS TITLE I?

- IT IS THE LARGEST FEDERAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR OUR NATION'S SCHOOLS.
- THE GOAL OF TITLE I IS A HIGHER QUALITY OF EDUCATION FOR EVERY CHILD.
- THE PROGRAM SERVES MILLIONS OF CHILDREN IN ELEMENTARY & SECONDARY SCHOOLS EACH YEAR.

HOW DOES TITLE I WORK?

- THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT PROVIDES FUNDING TO THE STATE.
- THE STATE EDUCATIONAL AGENCY SENDS THE MONEY TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT.
- THE SCHOOL DISTRICT IDENTIFIES ELIGIBLE SCHOOLS & PROVIDES TITLE I RESOURCES.
- TITLE I SERVES CHILDREN IN OUR DISTRICT THROUGH *SCHOOLWIDE PROGRAMS*.

PARENTAL NOTIFICATION – PARENTAL RIGHTS

AS A TITLE I FUNDED SCHOOL, WE PROVIDE PARENTS...

- INPUT WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE SCHOOLWIDE PLAN
- INPUT WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PARENT ENGAGEMENT PLAN
- TIMELY NOTIFICATION IF YOUR CHILD HAS BEEN TAUGHT FOR FOUR OR MORE WEEKS BY A TEACHER WHO IS NOT QUALIFIED
- INFORMATION ON YOUR CHILD'S ACHIEVEMENT LEVEL AS PER STATE ASSESSMENTS
- FREQUENT REPORTS ABOUT YOUR CHILD'S ACADEMIC PROGRESS
- WHETHER THEIR CHILD'S TITLE I SCHOOL IS MEETING THE ESSA STANDARDS

PARENTAL NOTIFICATION – PARENTAL RIGHTS

- WHAT IS BEING DONE TO IMPROVE YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL.
- NOTIFICATION IF YOUR CHILD ATTENDS A SCHOOL THAT IS IN SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT, OPTIONS AVAILABLE, SUCH AS PUBLIC SCHOOL CHOICE, OR THAT YOUR CHILD MAY BE ENTITLED TO SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES (SES), FROM AN APPROVED TUTORING PROVIDER.
- INFORMATION ON SUBMITTING COMMENTS AND THE COMPLAINT RESOLUTION PROCEDURE FOR TITLE I AND OTHER FEDERAL FUNDS.

PARENTAL NOTIFICATION – HIGHLY QUALIFIED

- WHETHER THEIR CHILD'S TEACHER IS QUALIFIED
 - HAS THE TEACHER MET STATE QUALIFICATION AND LICENSING CRITERIA FOR THE GRADE LEVELS AND SUBJECT AREAS IN WHICH THEY TEACH?
 - THE BACCALAUREATE DEGREE MAJOR AND/OR OTHER GRADUATE CERTIFICATION OR DEGREE HELD BY THE TEACHER.
 - THE FIELD OF DISCIPLINE OF THE CERTIFICATION OR DEGREE.
- WHETHER THE PARAPROFESSIONALS WORKING WITH YOUR CHILD ARE QUALIFIED.
